Pre-Arrival

Car Parking Facilities

- Two car parks are available for visitors. One holding approximately 130 car park spaces and another holding approximately 50 car park spaces.

- During opening hours the reception will be open in case visitors need assistance.
- Both car parks have lighting and are free of charge to those visitors, visiting The Limestone Heritage, Park and Gardens.

Entrance and Reception

- Door at entrance is made out of glass and visitors can be assisted by staff if required.

- Ticketing area is manned during opening hours.

Main Attraction Area
